The event is supported by the Herefordshire Climate & Nature Partnership Board. Chair, James Marsden (pictured fourth from right, alongside other board members), said: "We wanted to launch this special celebratory awareness week to shine a spotlight on how everyone can make a difference and to start conversations that inspire action."
